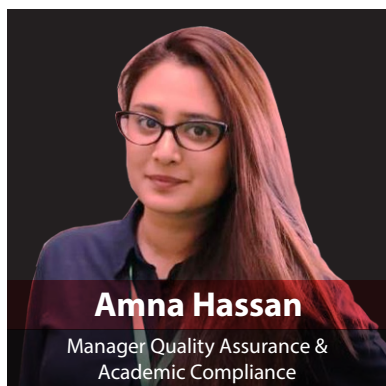

UNIVERSITY OF LONDON GRADUATION CEREMONY- LSE AND ROYAL HOLLOWAY

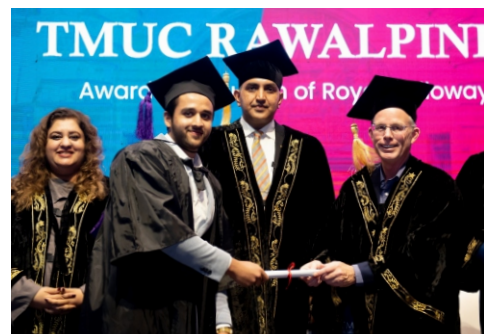
TMUC ISLAMABAD, BAHRIA SPRINGS & LAHORE

THE CENTRE FOR LAW & SECURITY SESSION


"Maritime Affairs & Blue Economy opportunities & challenges for Pakistan"

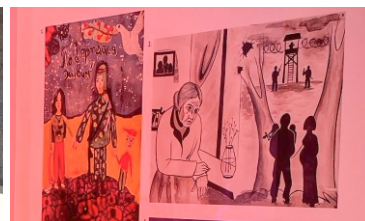

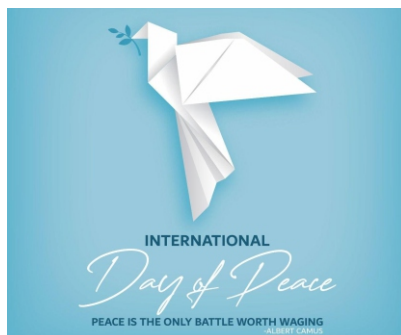
MEHFIL E MILAD AT TMUC CAMPUSES

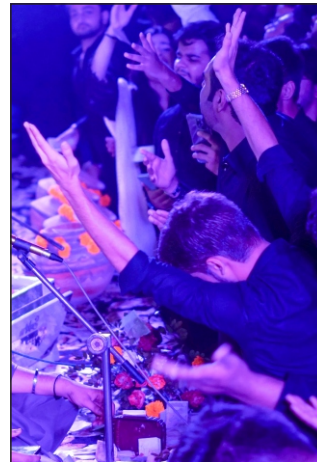

IN CONVERSATION WITH S. MOHAMMED RAZVI

I, Syed Mohammed Razvi, am an Advocate practising in Islamabad and specializing in Corporate & Commercial Litigation and Advisory. I graduated in the year 2020 with an LLB (Hons.) from TMUC. I studied from TMUC from 2017-2020 and during this time, had an incredible learning experience with the most qualified professors. More than simply learning the discipline of my degree, I had the pleasure of learning significant life-skills and organizational skills due to the accommodative nature of staff and faculty.

How did you decide to pursue your degree from TMUC?

Although I had no difficulties in choosing law as my profession of choice, and LLB as my degree of choice, the campus and faculty mattered a lot in making my decision to study at TMUC. 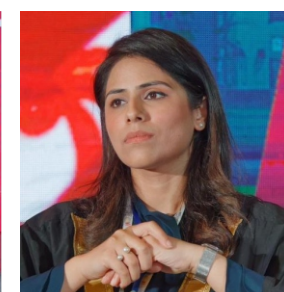

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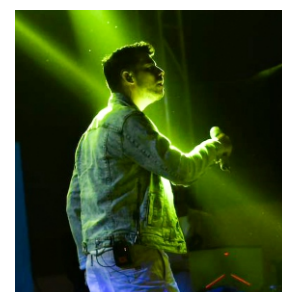
