



**VC Equality Scholarship Conditions**

- a. Recipients are chosen on the data received from the Department of Basic Education and the highest aggregate of all the marks achieved in the NSC examinations of Grade 12 is the starting point.
- b. To be eligible a student must be a South African citizen, writing the South African National Senior Certificate. In addition, a student must be offered a place to study at this institution and register for the programme offered.
- c. No re-marks are considered for this scholarship.
- d. Students cannot be awarded the Vice-Chancellor's Scholarship, the Vice-Chancellor's Equality Scholarship, and the University Entrance Scholarship at the same time. Students will be offered the most advantageous option but may elect accept another one of these three scholarships.
- e. Eligible Students will be required to sign a contract.
- f. The Scholarship only covers the cost of tuition.
- g. The scholarship is forfeited for the following years where a student fails an undergraduate course.
