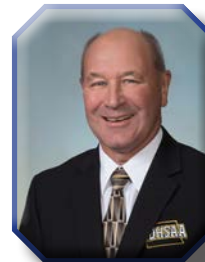

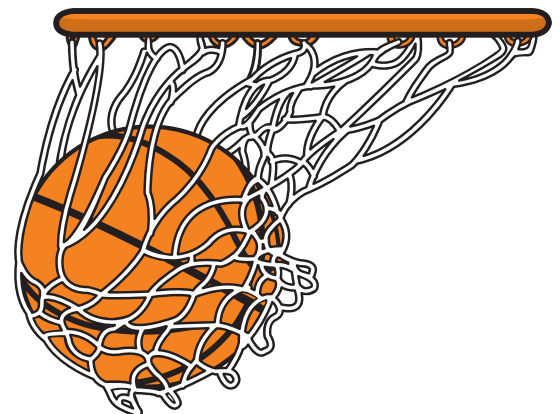

During his time as an official, Klier has officiated nine NDHSAA Class B Boys & Girls Basketball State Tournaments and two state championship games, 18 regional boys and girls basketball tournaments and numerous boys and girls district tournaments. The third time was the charm for the Bottineau Stars girls basketball team in 1999. The Stars qualified for the 1999 NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball State Tournament – the program’s third trip to “The B” since transitioning from Class A to Class B starting in the 1990 season. The trips to state in 1993 and 1996 ended without a state title, but the 1999 squad broke through for the school’s first ever girls basketball state championship.

Bottineau finished the regular season 16-3. The three losses all came against ranked opponents – Langdon, Starkweather-Munich and Mohall.

At the District 11 tournament, Bottineau picked up victories against Dunseith, Westhope-Newburg and Velva in the championship game. At the Region 6 Tournament, Bottineau defeated Des Lacs-Burlington in the quarterfinals and Westhope-Newburg in the semifinals to set up a rematch with Mohall – who had edged the Stars in the regular season by a score of 62-47 – in the Region 6 championship game. This time, it would be the Stars who would emerge victorious by a score of 56-54.

Langdon, Hazen, Oak Grove, Trenton, Hatton, Garrison, and Gackle-Streeter joined Bottineau at the 1999 NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball Tournament played at the Bismarck Civic Center.

Bottineau met Gackle-Streeter in the quarterfinals, a squad the Stars had defeated 50-47 in the regular season. The rematch between the Stars and the Orioles at state was even tighter than the regular season meeting as the game went to double overtime. Bottineau would prevail 50-42 and were led by senior center Robyn Hauge who scored 14 points. The Stars played three games that went to overtime during the 1999 season and won all three.

In the semifinals, Bottineau needed to rally from a fourth quarter deficit to defeat Garrison 49-43. Hauge posted a double-double (10 points and 13 rebounds) to lead the Stars. Senior guard Staci Marquardt hit a three-pointer in the fourth quarter to give Bottineau the lead back and senior guard Melissa Watson closed out the victory by making four straight free throws.

In the state championship, the Stars would get another chance to play a team that had defeated them in the regular season in the Langdon Cardinals. Bottineau, once again would avenge a regular season loss defeating Langdon 47-37. The Stars broke out to an early advantage and kept adding to it. Bottineau led by as many as 20 points at one point in the fourth quarter. Senior forward Sara Tonneson led the Stars with 27 points and was 12- for-15 shooting from the floor. Following the championship, Hauge and Tonneson were named to the All-Tournament team. Bottineau finished the 1999 season 25-3.

# NDHSAA Tournament Code of Conduct

Purpose: To elevate standards of Good Sportsmanship and to encourage the growth of responsible citizenship among the students, member schools and their personnel.

## FUNDAMENTALS OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP

1. Know, appreciate and understand the rules of the contest.
2. Show respect for the officials. Good Sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
3. Show respect for the opponent at all times. Good Sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
4. Recognize and appreciate the skill of performance regardless of team affiliation.
5. Maintain self control at all times. Good Sportsmanship is a responsibility of all who are involved in the game.
6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good Sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory".

## COACHES SHALL:

1. Follow the rules of the sport during the progress of the contest.
2. Accept the decision of officials without showing inappropriate emotions.
3. Exhibit encouragement to players going in and coming out of a game/meet.
4. Avoid public display of criticism in front of participants or spectators.

*"Good sportsmanship is displaying a commitment to fair play, ethics and integrity. Please display good sportsmanship throughout the tournament."*

*THANK YOU. Spectators displaying any unsportsmanlike conduct such as, but not limited to taunting, baiting or carrying flags around the arena, will be removed."*

## TEAMS SHALL:

1. Display qualities of Good Sportsmanship at all times.
2. Display respect for opponents at all times, including injured players. EXAMPLE: Assisting an opponent who has fallen as opposed to stepping over him/her.
3. Avoid unsportsmanlike gestures or language. EXAMPLE: Taunting an opponent after a missed shot, etc.
4. Respect the judgment of game officials. EXAMPLE: Protesting a call verbally and/or demonstratively.
5. Concentrate on being involved in the contest with as little regard for the spectators as possible. EXAMPLE: Joining in with spectators in unsportsmanlike conduct.
6. Accept victory and/or defeat with pride and compassion. EXAMPLE: Shaking hands with the opponents after the contest in a sportsmanlike manner.
7. Exhibit proper etiquette in pre-game ceremonies. EXAMPLE: Display proper behavior during the national anthem, the introduction of players, etc.
8. Display ethical behavior throughout the contest. EXAMPLE: No behavior which would include possible injurious actions such as the swinging of elbows, tripping, pushing back after being bumped, etc.

## FANS SHALL:

1. Refrain from throwing any object onto the playing floor or in the stands.
2. Refrain from behavior deemed dangerous or which interferes with the rights of others to watch the game.
3. Refrain from possessing, consuming or being under the influence of chemicals.
4. Refrain from use of obscene, profane or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters or banners which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band or other performing groups.
5. Refrain from the use of artificial noisemakers.
6. Refrain from entry onto the playing surface.

**THESE ARE ACTS OF MISCONDUCT THAT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC REMOVAL WITHOUT REFUND OF ADMISSION!**

## CROWD CONTROL

1. Officials should be encouraged to call penalties on crowd or to cancel or postpone games because of improper crowd behavior.
2. The host school administration is responsible for crowd control and may call the game because of fan misconduct and postpone the conclusion of a game until a later time with no spectators present.
3. Student spectators guilty of misconduct should be removed from the arena and charged with disorderly conduct and/or may be barred from attending future contests.
4. All school regulations should be in effect at all contests, even though the contest might not be held in a school owned facility.
