

- General chemistry with lab 8 credit hours
- Organic chemistry with lab 8 credit hours
- General Biology with lab 4 credit hours
- Anatomy & Physiology (one course covering the whole body, or a two-course progression) – 4 credit hours
- Microbiology with lab 4 credit hours
- Statistics 3 credit hours

## For applicants without bachelor's degree, all of the previous requirements, plus:

- English Composition 6 credit hours
- Humanities/Fine Arts or Social/Behavior Sciences – 12 credit hours
- Electives –12 credit hours (recommended: pharmaceutical sciences, clinical research, advanced biology or chemistry courses)

Minimum 64 credit hours including all prerequisites are required for eligibility for acceptance.
